



ACCESS TIPS

Please pay close attention to the following bullets as they outline simple and easy *one-time* access tips.

- ⇒ Once you click the Subscribe button you'll be redirected to PayPal. Just fill out the payment information and once you're on the page titled You Have Completed Your Purchase, click on the Return to Journal of Pure Power button. Now you're back at *JOPP* and all you need to do is give us your name and e-mail address, click the Submit button, and you'll be issued an access code immediately and you'll be redirected to another page from which you download your fist issue. It's that easy.
- ⇒ After you downloaded the file check your e-mail for your access code, it comes immediately from access@cbprotect.com. If you don't see this e-mail it's because you have Spam or Junk software installed and your computer didn't recognize it as legitimate. If so, simply retrieve the e-mail from the folder where your computer places spam.
- ⇒ Once you receive the access code, make sure you're still Online and **make absolutely certain** that *if* you have a firewall installed or On, that you momentarily turn it off. **This is the most critical step you *must* observe and is essential for smooth and uncomplicated access.**

To turn off your firewall in Windows, follow these steps, which may vary slightly between Windows operating systems (Windows Vista and 7 is addressed on page 2.). (If you have additional firewalls installed, please refer to that software's Help to determine how to turn it off.)

- Click on Start
- Click on Control Panel
- Double-click Security Center
- Click on Recommendations
- Click Disable Now

To turn your firewall back on once you gained access to *JOPP*, follow the same process and click Enable Now at the end.

- ⇒ Next, unzip the folder you downloaded by double-clicking it and/or choosing Extract Folder (depending on the age of your operating system and software, unzipping might be slightly different, and might even occur automatically, but still very easy to do). Next your computer will ask you to Run the program, which you should do by clicking the appropriate buttons.
- ⇒ [If at this point you run into a problem such as a window stating: "Administrator or Super-user status is required to validate this product. You do not have the required access rights to validate your use of this product.", it is an indication that you either need to right-click the file and choose the option "Access as an Administrator" or you may need to change your computer's settings to recognize you as an Administrator (see page 2 for more).]
- ⇒ In the new window input your access code where indicated (it's best you Copy it from the e-mail and Paste it to avoid mistyping) and then click Validate Purchase while being Online. If you have a Firewall, you may now turn it back on.
- ⇒ You only need to execute this process this one time and you need not be Online to read *JOPP* (though you will need to be Online to take advantage of some of the embedded links). Once validated, *JOPP* will open automatically and so will all successive issues WITHOUT repeating this access process (for future issues you simply click on the URL we will provide you with, download the issue, unzip it, Run it, and open it).
- ⇒ Since *JOPP* cannot be transferred or shared, please make sure you gain access on the computer you want to use to read *JOPP* (e.g., work vs. home).
- ⇒ If you get a new computer or for another reason require a new access code, scroll down our Subscribe page and click on the Access Code button. We will revoke your previous code and issue a new one within 24 hours.

Windows Vista Security Information

JOPP's security features are Vista compatible. If you have Vista and are experiencing issues validating the software, please ensure you're logged in as admin (right click on our product icon you downloaded and run the program as admin).

To turn off Windows Firewall

1. Open Security Center by clicking the Start button Picture of the Start button, clicking Control Panel, clicking Security, and then clicking Security Center.
2. Click Firewall, and then click Turn off now. Administrator permission required. If you are prompted for an administrator password or confirmation, type the password or provide confirmation.

Notes

* If you have a firewall other than Windows firewall, check the information that came with the firewall or go to the manufacturer's web site to find out how to turn it off.

* Windows does not detect all firewalls. If you are sure that you have a firewall installed and turned on/off, you can click Show me my available options to stop receiving notifications from Security Center about your firewall. If you do this, Windows will not monitor your firewall status or alert you if it is off.

If the firewall is off, Security Center will display a notification and put a Security Center icon in the notification area. For more information about Windows Vista Security, [click here](#).

Vista also has added security, so be certain you're able to access the Internet through your security and firewalls.

Sometimes, even if you're logged in as administrator, Windows Vista UAC (User Account Control) causes some programs to treat the user as a normal user without administrative privileges. In this case you have to turn off the UAC function. [Click here](#) for the How To.

Windows 7 Security Information

This Operating System is also vulnerable to your personal preference settings regarding security. The settings you have chosen may, therefore, interfere with gaining access to *JOPP* or you experience no problems at all and access is easy, direct, and quick.

One error message you may encounter is that your computer is not recognizing you as an Administrator or Super-User, thus not allowing you to validate *JOPP*. To change your preference settings, follow the Windows 7 instructions [here](#). On the right of that page, click on User Accounts and follow the steps necessary to set your computer up to recognize you as an Administrator.
